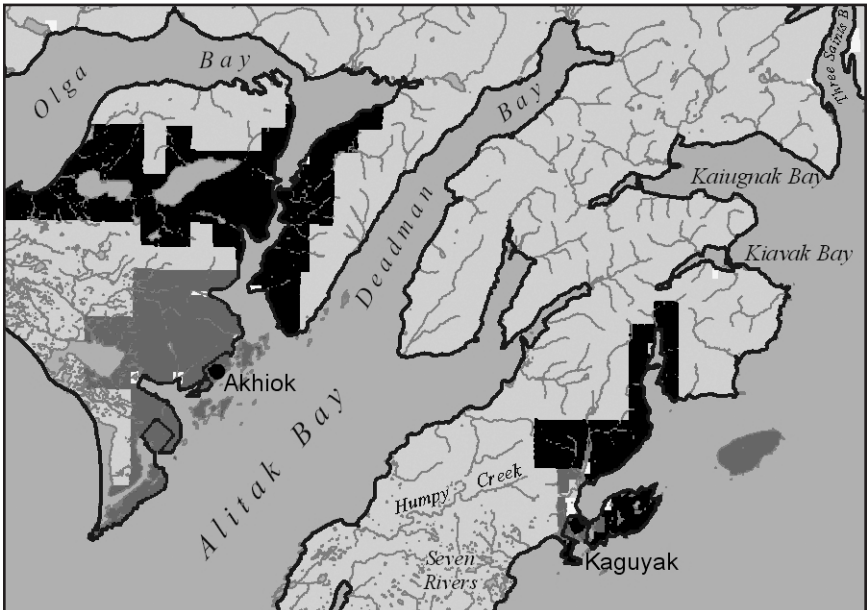

OVER FOR TERMS OF LICENSE



■ Conservation Easement - Public Use Areas ■ Closed Lands - NO Public Use

By signing this license, I agree to comply with the following terms and conditions:

1. I, as Licensee, understand that this license grants temporary access to conservation easement lands which is privately owned by Akhiok-Kaguyak, Inc. (AKI). Applicant shall avoid trespass on other private properties adjacent to the permit areas and treat their owners and properties with respect.
2. I acknowledge that use of this land is a privilege. I agree that failure to observe Federal, State or Local Laws or regulations, interference with rights and customs of local residents, interference with local fishermen or fish-camps, failure to exercise due care in use of the land, or violation of any of the terms or conditions stated here in shall cause immediate and automatic revocation of this license and may be grounds for a damage claim.
3. I understand that the AKI lands are remote, wilderness lands which are inherently dangerous and which are inhabited by wild, potentially dangerous animals. I understand that the AKI easement lands are unimproved, although they may, in fact, include finished and/or unmaintained improvements, including but not limited to cabins, trails, airstrips, known or unknown to AKI, that could present potential hazards. I further acknowledge that the remote and dangerous nature of the AKI lands may make rescue and assistance in the event of an emergency difficult or impossible, and that AKI has no duty, obligation or ability to undertake any rescue effort or to provide any assistance to me.
4. I assume any and all risks, of whatsoever kind or nature, whether natural or man made, which may occur during my presence on AKI lands. I hereby waive, relinquish, release and discharge AKI, it's officers, directors, employees, agents, contractors, successors and assigns from any and all claims, actions damages or liabilities including but not limited to damages for death, personal injury or injury to property arising out of or resulting from this agreement or the use of the AKI lands.
5. This license is issued for non-exclusive temporary fishing, hunting and recreational use only. I agree that the land will not be used for any commercial purpose unless authorized in writing by an authorized corporate officer.
6. All camping shall be "leave no trace" camping, with all temporary structures and other traces of the campsite cleaned up and left in as good or better condition as when I arrived. Before leaving, I agree to haul out and properly dispose of all trash and litter. No trash or fish will be buried in the area.
7. Campfires are allowed only by clearing vegetation to mineral soil to a minimum of two (2) feet in diameter. Campfires are not permitted on mossy or organic soils. Fuel is limited to down and dead wood. Permit holder agrees to completely extinguish camp fires before vacating an area, and agrees that he/she is fully liable for costs and damages caused by uncontrolled campfires. All reasonable precautions shall be taken to prevent wildland fires. I shall make every effort to suppress any fire that I start and shall report any out of control fire that I've started or observe as soon as possible to the Alaska Division of Forestry (907) 262-4124, 911 after hours and to AKI at (907) 258-0604 immediately.
8. No live vegetation shall be cut, damaged or removed unnecessarily.
9. All motorized land vehicles are prohibited.
10. Any archeological properties, artifacts, and/or grave sites are not to be disturbed, If discovered, AKI is to be notified at (907) 258-0604 immediately.
11. This permit is the property of AKI and must be provided to AKI upon request. Failure to comply with these permit rules will result in revocation and possible denial of future permit applications.
12. If any provisions of this Agreement, or any portion thereof, are determined to be unlawful or without force and effect, the remaining portions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
